Dear Delegate:

This correspondence is official notification that all funded delegates/alternates delegates must remit their Good Faith Money no later than March 6, 2006. March 6, 2006 is date of the regular meeting of the Branch. The Convention Committee will not accept any Good Faith Money after March 6, 2006. A funded delegate that fails to remit their Good Faith Money by March 6, 2006, will become a non-funded delegate. **The last day that you can cancel and have your Good Faith Money refunded is July 3, 2006.**

You can also fill out, digitally sign, and print the 2006 Hotel Reservation Form on the Internet or you can download the 2006 Hotel Reservation Form to your computer, fill it out, digitally and/or manually sign and print it. If have decided or if you later decide that you will not attend the Las Vegas convention, you can also fill out, digitally sign, and print the 2006 Convention Delegate Cancel Notice or you can download it to your computer, fill it out, digitally and/or manually sign and print it.

The 65<sup>th</sup> Biennial State Convention will be held in Las Vegas, NV, beginning on Sunday, August 13<sup>th</sup> and ending on Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2006. If the Las Vegas convention is your first convention please inform the Convention Committee.

Good Faith Money for this convention is \$122 per funded delegate. Please make note that the total amount due as of this date for the Las Vegas Hilton is \$122.08/night (taxes included).

The Convention Committee will request that Branch 142 be lodged at the: 1) Las Vegas Hilton or; 2) Riviera Hotel and Casino or; 3) Flamingo Las Vegas. The NALC Housing Committee makes the hotel assignment determination not the Branch 142 Convention Committee.

Only the following methods of payment will be accepted: cashier's check, official bank check or money order. **NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Make your cashier's check, official bank check, or money order payable to Capitol Branch 142, NALC. Do not make your cashier's check, official bank check or money order payable to the Convention Committee. It is your responsibility to request a receipt and retain it as proof of payment.


Any **bank draft** that fails to clear our bank for any reason, the delegate still has the responsibility to remit their Good Faith Money no later than March 6, 2006. Failure to remit your Good Faith Money by March 6, 2006, will result in a funded delegate becoming non-funded. There is a \$25.00 fee for **all bank drafts that are returned**.

The Convention Committee will be at the Union Hall on March 1, 2006 at approximately 5:00 p.m. until approximately 10 p.m. for delegates that want to remit their Good Faith Money prior to March 6, 2006. Delegates may drop-off their Good Faith Money any time prior to March 6, 2006. If you mail your Good Faith Money it must be **received** no later than March 6, 2006.

You must submit a Hotel Reservation Form with your Good Faith Money. If you are sharing a room with a delegate and the room will not be reserved in your name, do not complete the Hotel Reservation Form. However, you must make sure your name is entered in the "Name of Each Delegate Sharing A Room" section on the Hotel Reservation Form for the delegate who's name the room will be reserved in. If you are not sharing a room with a delegate, you must complete the Hotel Reservation Form.
